7. perterritus, perterrita, perterritum – terrified

8. pes, pedis, m – foot, paw

9. sanguis, sanguinis, m – blood

10. totus, tota, totum – whole

11. adjective – describes nouns (matches gender, number, case)

12. superlative – highest degree or quality (issimus, errimus)

13. nominative – subject endings (singular: a, us, ?; plural: ae, i, es)

14. accusative – direct object endings (singular: am, um, em; plural: as, os, es)

15. subject – does the action
