Write 1 of the sentences in each box and illustrate it.</p>	<p><u>True or False</u> Write 10 statements about the story in English. 5 of the statements must be true and 5 must be false. Be sure to mark which answer is correct.</p>	<p><u>My Perspective</u> Rewrite the story from your own perspective: as if you were the main character in the story and you were telling the story about yourself.</p>
<p><u>Close reading</u> In Latin, write down which sentence of the story you think . . .</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. is the most important sentence 2. is the most surprising sentence 3. is your favorite sentence 4. is the most confusing sentence 5. is the least interesting sentence <p>Then, in English, explain WHY you made each of your choices.</p>	<p><u>One Pager</u> Create a “one pager” about the story you read that clearly demonstrates your understanding of the story. You are welcome to use words or images, as long as I can get a good sense of what the story is about from your one pager.</p> 	<p><u>The 5 W's</u> Answers these questions about the story IN ENGLISH (1) WHO and (2) WHAT is the story about? (3) WHY do they do what they do? (4) WHERE and (5) WHEN does the story take place?</p>
<p><u>Story Time</u> Create a video/audio recording of yourself reading the Latin story aloud. Then give a brief English summary of what you read at the end. You will have to bring your Chromebook to class or do this at home.</p>	<p><u>Be the Teacher</u> Create a Google Slides/Powerpoint presentation of the story with the paragraphs broken up into smaller chunks and pictures to help with the understanding of the key vocabulary.</p>	<p><u>Emojis</u> Create an “Emoji retell” version of the story. You will need to include a paragraph summary explaining your Emoji choices.</p> <p>Again, keep it school appropriate.</p>
